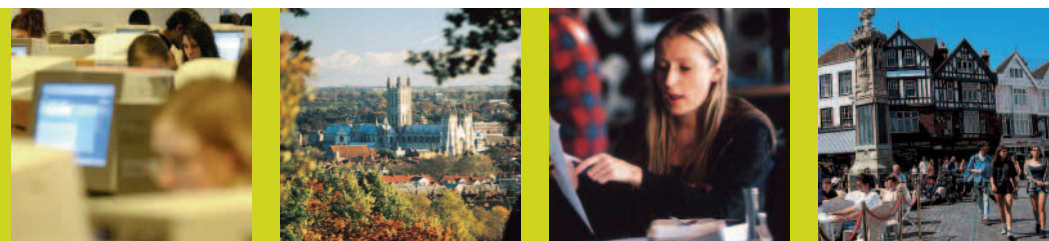

The University of Kent is now accepting applications for its one-year Masters and three-year PhD degrees in Social Psychology. Kent has one of the largest groups of experts in social psychology in Europe. Our group's research was given the highest possible rating (5\*) by the 2001 UK Research Assessment Exercise (RAE). We offer a supportive, dynamic and diverse environment for creative research and learning. We use a variety of methods in basic and applied psychology including experimental, survey and archival approaches in the following areas of social psychology:

- **Intergroup and intragroup relations**
- **Social identity and prejudice across the lifespan**
- **Attitudes and emotions**
- **Social cognition**
- **Self-regulation**
- **Power, status and leadership**
- **Personality, culture and communication**
- **Evolutionary and existential perspectives**

Our PhD students are funded by scholarships and grants, departmental studentships and/or part-time teaching. Applications are welcome at any time of the year for our three MSc degrees in (1) social and applied psychology, (2) group processes and intergroup relations and (3) research methods which start in mid-September, and for PhD studies to begin at any time but preferably September.
