

Extraordinary Grants 2021 - FAQ

1. Can I apply for both new grant schemes at the same time?

No, you can only apply for one of the two schemes at the same time.

2. Can I apply for the “Societal Relevance of Social Psychology” grant if I have received funding from EASP during the last 5 years?

No, you cannot apply if you have received a seedcorn/Covid-19 or collaborative grant during the last 5 years. Exceptions are Summer School related seedcorn grants, pre-registration and travel grants. Also the EASP meeting support does not exclude you from applying.

3. Can I apply for the “Double Burden Corona Relief ” grant if I have received funding from EASP during the last 5 years?

Yes, you may apply.

4. Is the “Double Burden Corona Relief ” grant only open to female researchers?

Male researchers can also suffer from a double burden during the Corona pandemic. While we recognize greater disparities among our female colleagues, we are open to justified cases from everybody.

5. My co-applicants received funding from EASP in the past 5 years. Can we apply as a team?

Yes, you may apply. We are basing our evaluation on the principal investigator.

6. Can I use the funds under the “Double Burden Corona Relief ” grant to extend my own contract or that of a PhD student?

No, you cannot use the funds for these purposes. Funds may be used for direct research costs or research assistants only.

7. Until when must the approved funds be used?

Funds from both the “Societal Relevance of Social Psychology” grant and the “Double Burden Corona Relief” grant must be used within 2021 (full financial accounting must be finished by 31.12.2021).

8. Is it possible to deduct an institutional overhead?

No, the EASP does not cover institutional overheads.
